What is Draw to Remember?

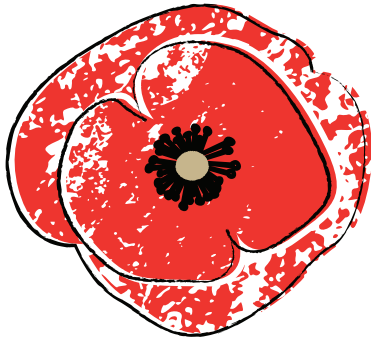
For this activity, we're going to make a chalk drawing for Remembrance Day to honour the men and women who died while serving in our Defence Force.

What is Remembrance Day?

World War I ended at 11:00am on 11 November 1918. 11 November is now known as Remembrance Day. It's when we remember service people who lost their lives in wars, conflicts and peacekeeping missions.

How do we remember?

- Stay silent for a minute at 11:00am on 11 November
- Wear a red poppy – a symbol of remembrance
- Attend an RSL memorial service



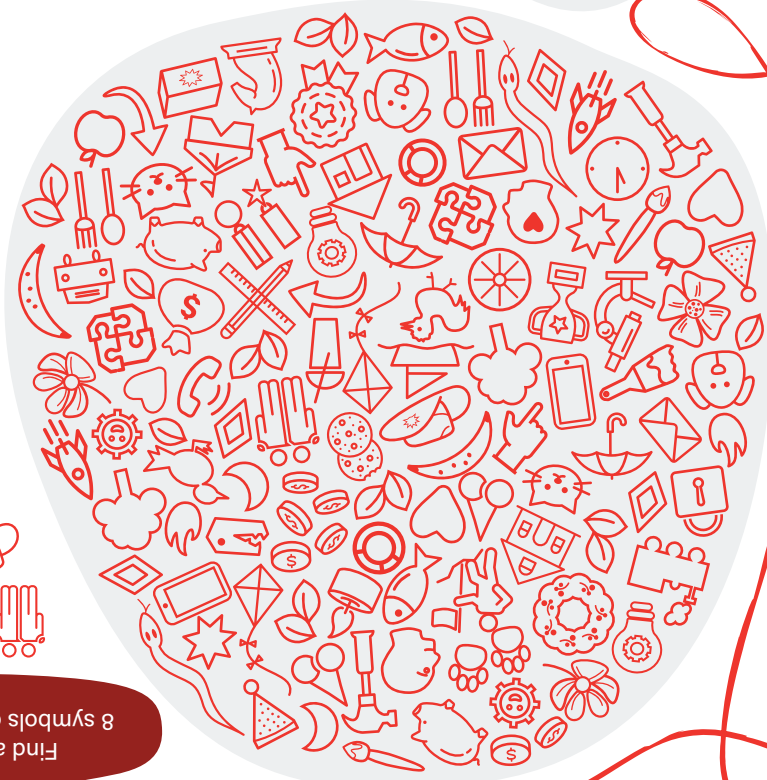
